Impact:

The Academy's staff model allows for personalized instruction and mentorship. With small student-to-teacher ratios, every scholar benefits from individualized academic guidance and emotional support. Learning coaches strengthen daily instruction, mentors provide ongoing life skills and leadership development, and the cheer coach promotes school pride, teamwork, and morale.

This multi-tiered staffing design ensures that learning is consistent, relational, and purpose-driven.
